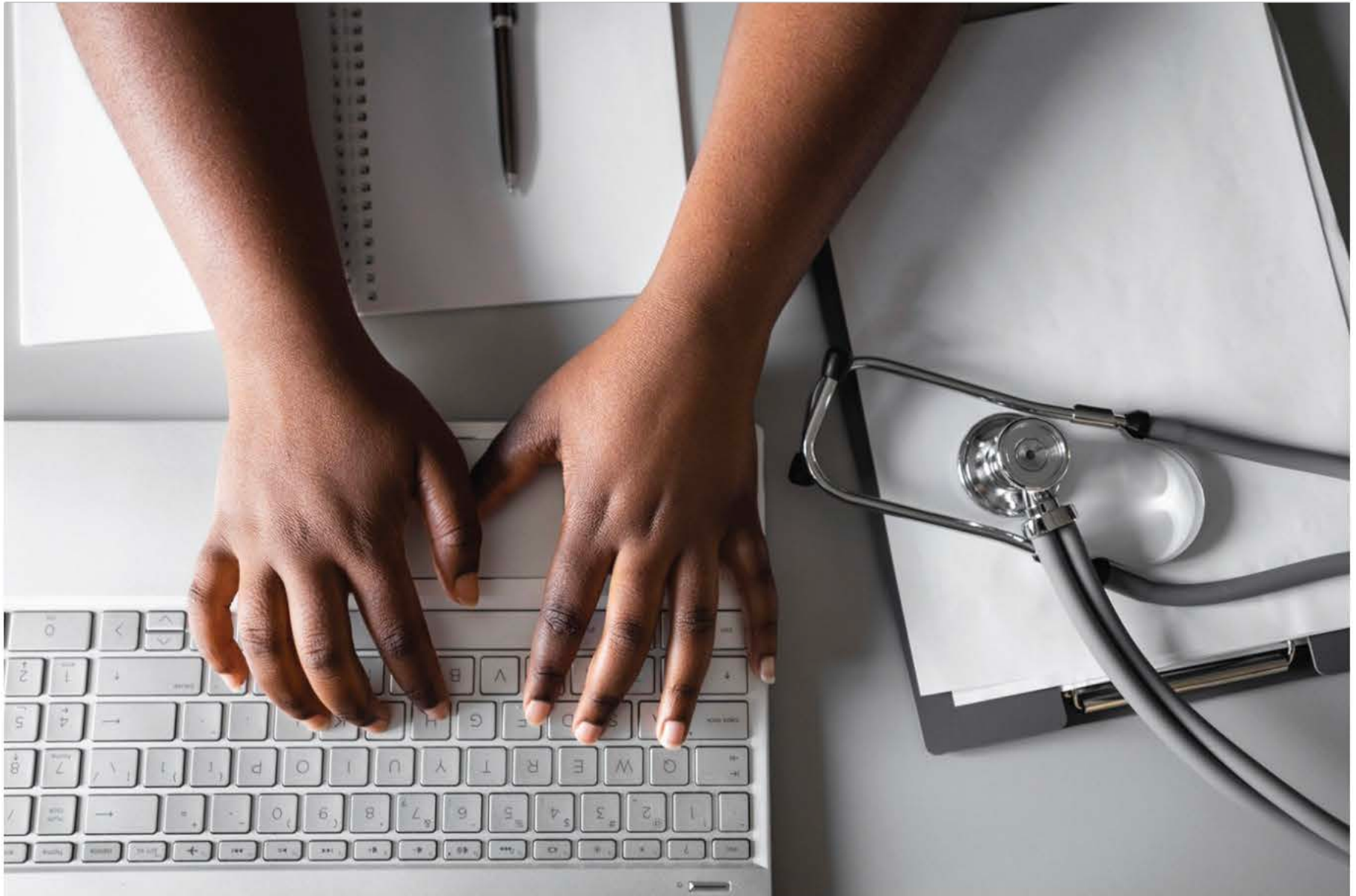

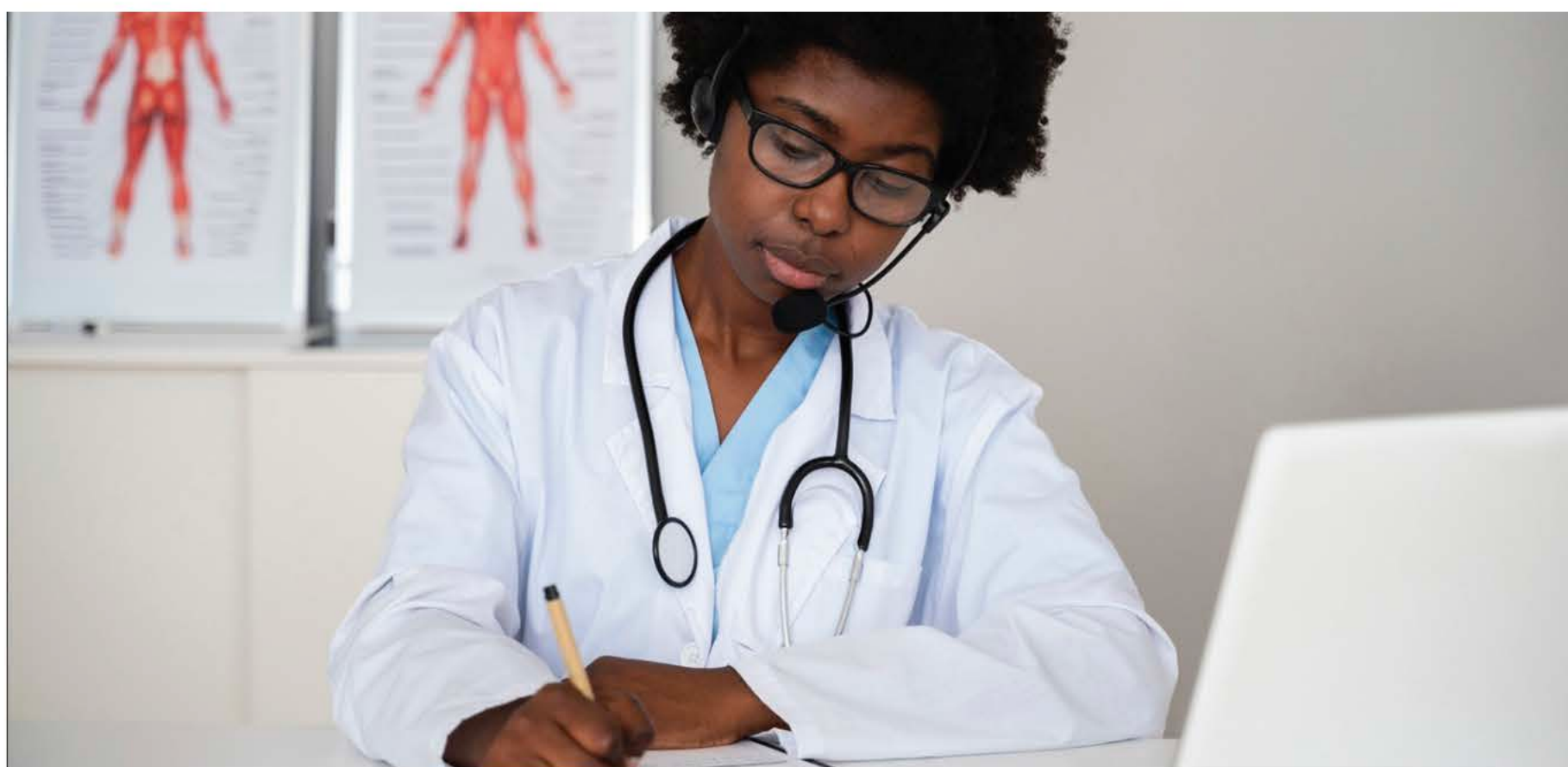

4. Absence of comprehensive future medical needs projection.

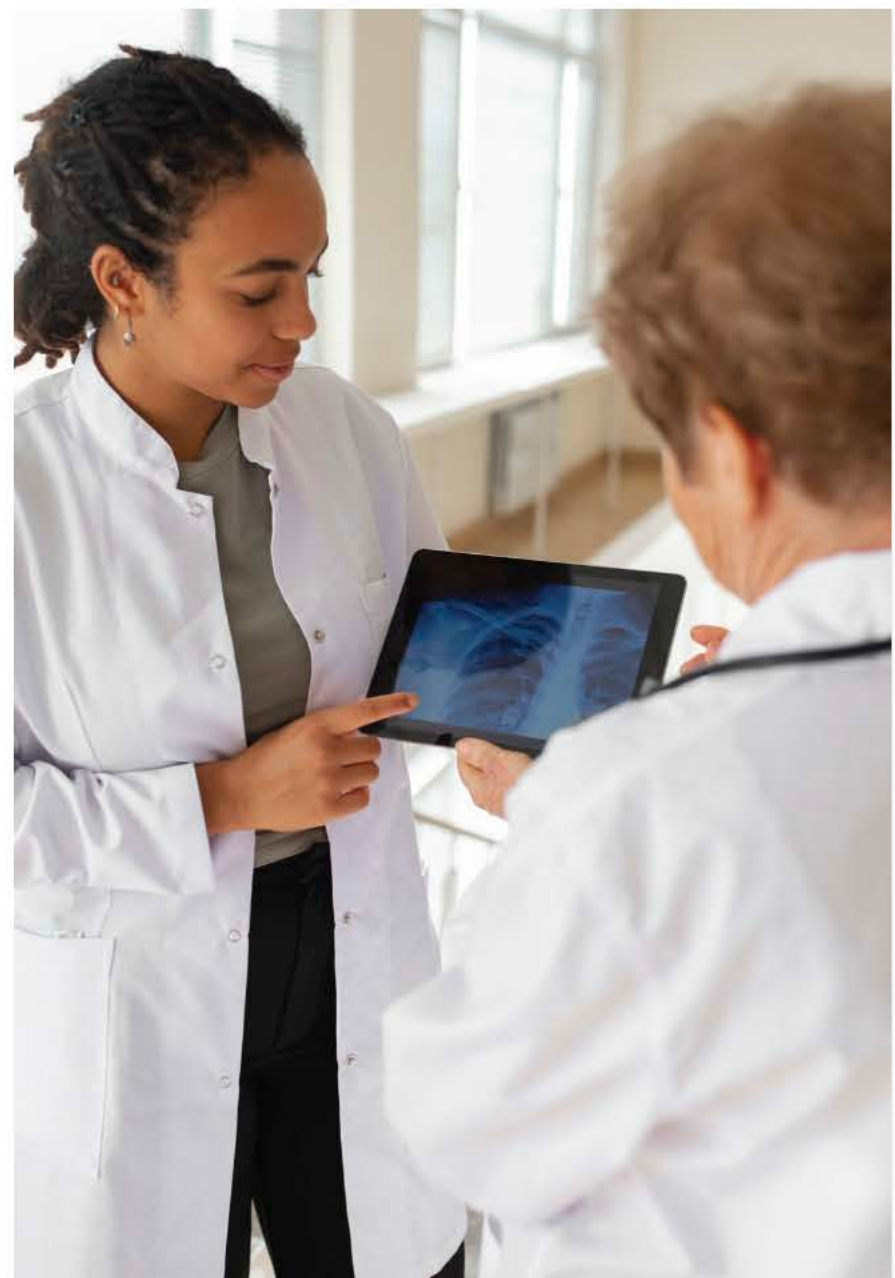

Multiple impairments from different body systems are combined using the Combined Values Chart (CVC) under AMA VI to reflect the total Whole Person Impairment (WPI). Accurate combination methodology often significantly impacts the ultimate qualifying threshold.
